### **NORTH DAKOTA HAS \$552,098 WILD CARD 2 JACKPOT WINNER**

Bismarck – A winning Wild Card 2 ticket worth \$552,098 was drawn in North Dakota on Saturday, September 15. The winning ticket was purchased at Farmer's Union Oil in Beulah. The winning numbers were 10, 15, 23, 24 and 25 and the Wild Card was the Ace of Spades.

Players should check their tickets for winning numbers. Although the holder of the winning ticket has 180 days to claim the cash prize, the Lottery recommends that the winning player contact the Lottery as soon as possible at 701-328-1574. Lottery hours are Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., CST.

Lottery Director Chuck Keller suggests that anyone who wins a large cash prize sign the ticket before claiming the prize. "Unless you sign a ticket, anyone who has the ticket can claim the prize," said Keller.

Four states – North Dakota, South Dakota, Montana, and Idaho – participate in the Wild Card 2 game. North Dakota Lottery players have won six of the last nine Wild Card 2 jackpots – over \$2.1 million dollars.

Another lucky player won \$50,000 playing Powerball. Because the winning ticket was purchased with the Power Play multiplier, the usual \$10,000 prize was multiplied by five times making the prize worth \$50,000. The winning ticket was purchased at Garrison Bay Express in Garrison.
