\$200,000 POWERBALL TICKET SOLD IN FARGO

Although Wednesday night's \$120 million Powerball jackpot was not hit, Lady Luck found a player with a \$200,000 winning ticket for the November 21st draw. The winning ticket was sold at Stop N Go located at 4301 13th Avenue SW in Fargo. The lucky Powerball numbers were 3, 11, 13, 20, 40 and the Powerball number was 20.

The \$200,000 winning ticket matched all five white numbers, but not the Powerball – only one number away from the \$120 million jackpot. The ticket was purchased without the Power Play option. If the player had purchased the Power Play option, the \$200,000 prize would have been multiplied by 2, making the prize worth \$400,000.

The winning ticket still has not been claimed. To check tickets for winning numbers, visit a participating Lottery retailer, look online at www.lottery.nd.gov, or call 701-328-1111.

The Lottery recommends that players sign the back of tickets before claiming the ticket or presenting it to a retailer to scan for winning numbers. "Unless you sign a ticket, the person who has custody of the ticket can claim the prize," said Lottery Director Chuck Keller. "To protect yourself, sign the back of your tickets when you buy them." Players have 180 days to claim a cash prize.

For Saturday's draw, the estimated Powerball Jackpot has climbed to \$137 million.
